THE LATE NIGHT LEVY (EXPENSES, EXEMPTIONS AND REDUCTIONS)
REGULATIONS 2012**



Regulation 3(1) of the Late Night Levy (Expenses, Exemptions and Reductions) Regulations 2012 describes the categories of expenses which a licensing authority may deduct for the purposes of calculating the net amount of levy payments for any period. Section 130(5)(a) of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 requires a licensing authority to publish, before the beginning of each levy year, a statement of its estimate of the amount of deductions permitted under those Regulations.

For the levy year from 1st April 2016 to 31st March 2017, Southampton City Council estimates that the amount of permitted deductions will be £6,000.
