

8. Employment Domain

The employment domain measures involuntary exclusion of the working age population from the world of work.

This domain combines the following indicators,

- Recipients of Jobseekers Allowance (both contribution-based and income based): men aged 18-64 and women aged 18-59 (Source: DWP 2005).
- Recipients of Incapacity Benefit: men aged 18-64 and women aged 18-59 (Source: DWP 2005).
- Recipients of Severe Disablement Allowance: men aged 18-64 and women aged 18-59 (Source: DWP 2005).
- Participants in the New Deal for the 18-24s who are not in receipt of JSA (Source: DWP 2005).
- Participants in the New Deal for 25+ who are not in receipt of JSA (Source: DWP 2005).
- Participants in the New Deal for Lone Parents (after initial interview) (Source: DWP 2005).

Changes from the IMD 2004

There are no substantive changes in respect of the indicators from IMD 2004 but a small methodological shift.

The first three LSOAs, in this table, are within the 10% most deprived in England in the IMD 2007. LSOA E01017281, which covers Weston Park and International way in Woolston, is the most employment deprived LSOA in Southampton. With a LSOA in Thornhill ranked second and the LSOA that covers Northam in third place. Approximately 3,100 people or 2.1% of the working age population live in the LSOAs in the 10% most deprived in England.
