



PRE-SCHOOL EMOTIONAL LITERACY LIST 2009

The intention of these lists is to provide a memory jogger for Parents, Teachers and Librarians, enabling them to find books already available in libraries both Public Libraries and at school or through the School Library Service, to support work concerning, emotions, values, citizenship and pastoral problems. The titles are primarily aimed at Pre-School and Key Stage 1 reception age but there are some titles that could be used with slightly older children.

Where possible, the titles are recent publications, though there are some older titles listed which are so appropriate and being classics will be readily available and usually still in print.

The lists are not intended as bibliographical tools for ordering books. Some of the titles are now out of print. Many books are available in hardback, paperback and even big book editions from library stocks. There are a small number of non-fiction titles that were felt to be appropriate, but the list of non-fiction is not exhaustive. Some indication has been given as to whether the titles are more suitable for Pre-School or Key Stage 1. BB indicates a board book version of a title that is sometimes also available in mainstream picture books.
