

12. Supplementary Income Deprivation Affecting Children Domain

This domain is a subset of the Income Domain, and measures the number of children in households with low incomes

This domain measures the % of children under 16 whose families were in receipt of the following,

- Income Support
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- Working Families Tax Credit households whose income is below 60% median before housing costs
- Disabled Persons Tax Credit households whose income is below 60% median before housing costs

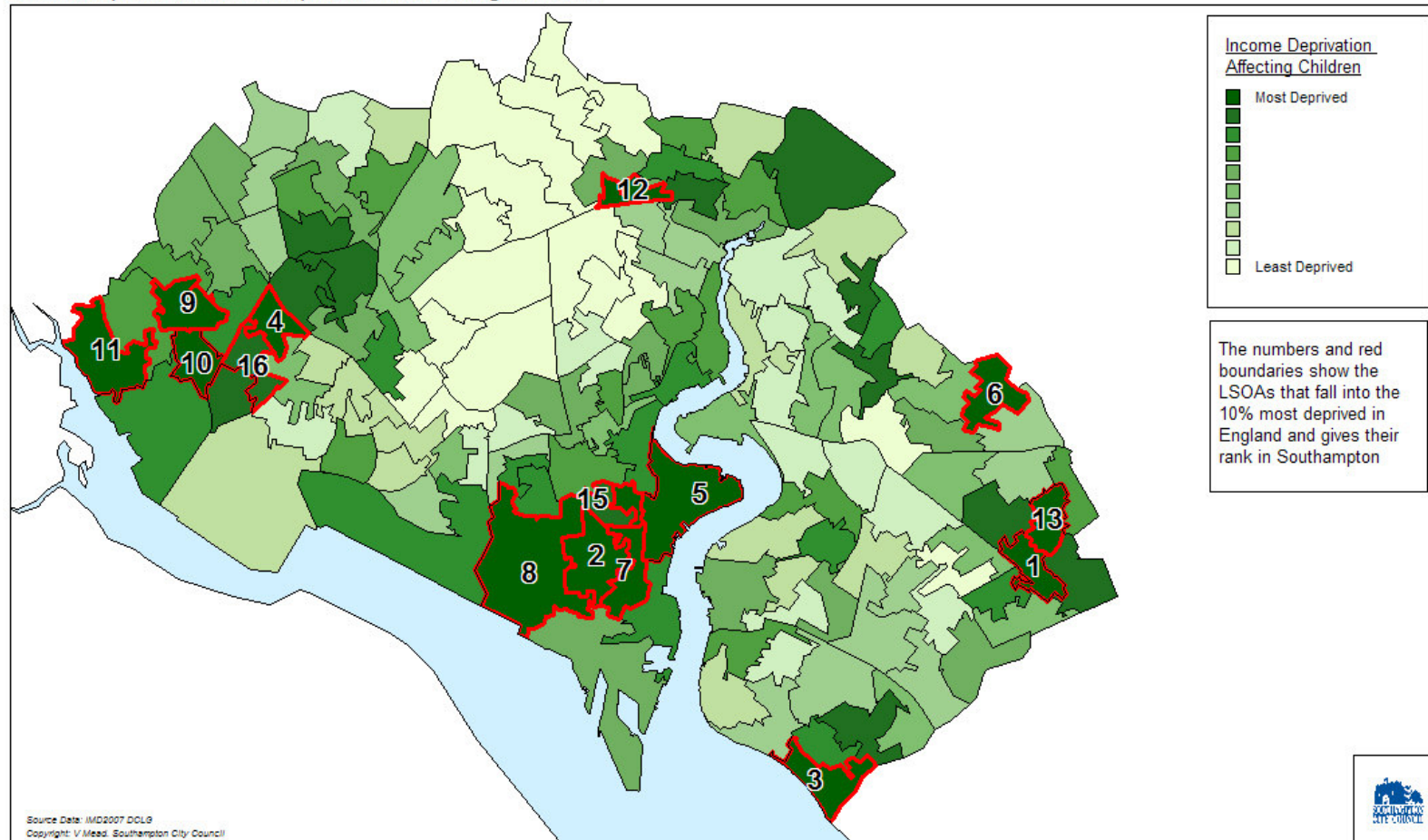

The first 9 LSOAs in the table above fall into the 10% most deprived in England. These LSOA are concentrated mostly around the priority neighbourhoods of Bevois and Bargate, Outer Shirley, Weston and Harefield. Approximately 5,700 people or 15.2% of the 0-15 year old population live in the LSOAs in the 10% most deprived in England.

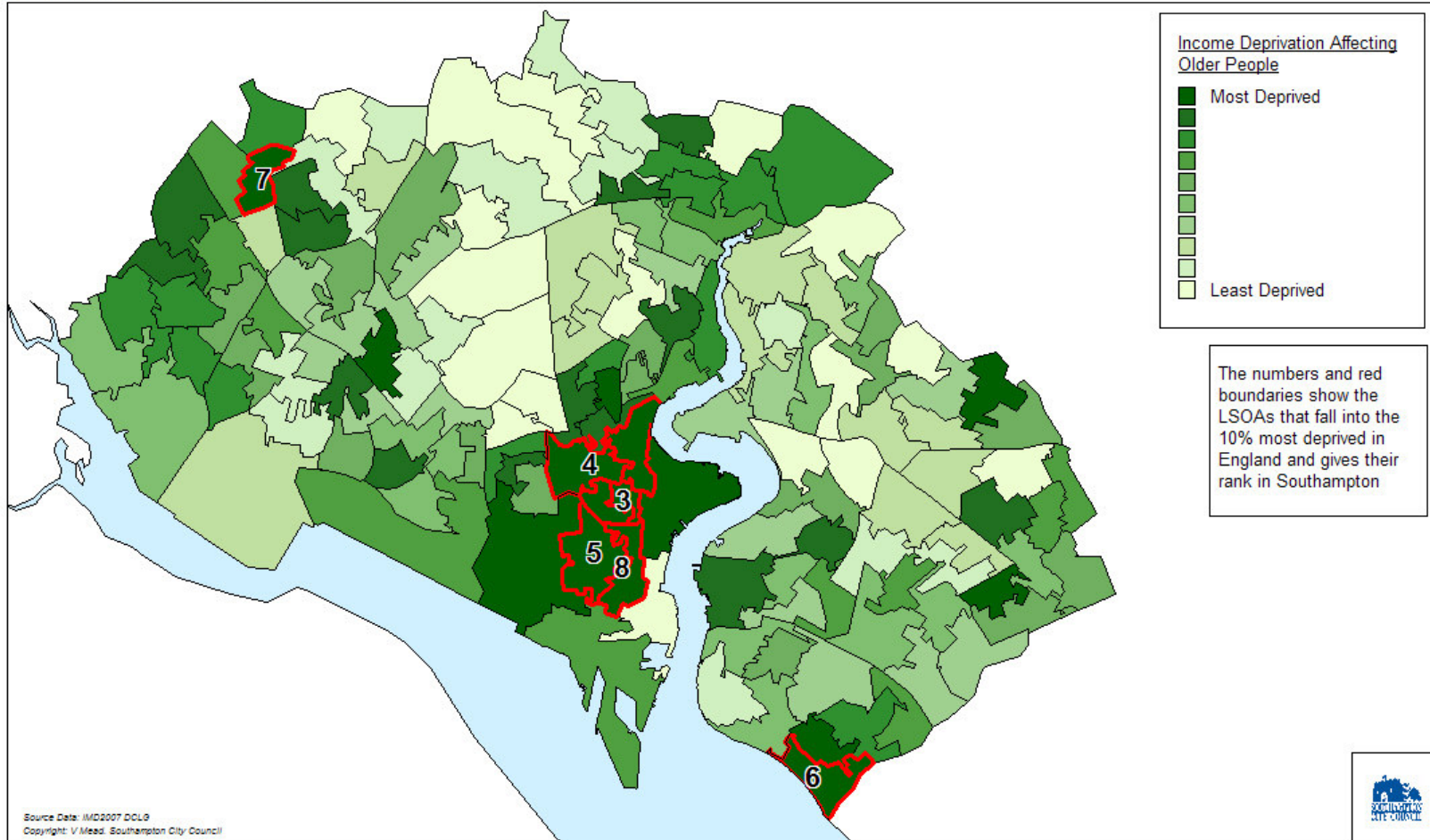

The majority of the LSOA with older people income deprivation are concentrated around the centre of Southampton with the exception of Weston

and Lordshill. Approximately 1,700 people or 4.3% of people aged 60 and over live in the LSOAs in the 10% most deprived in England.
