UNRULY CONDUCT IN PLACES OF PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENT

Byelaw made by the Southampton County Borough Council on the seventeenth day of August One thousand nine hundred and sixty in pursuance of the provisions of Section 249 of the Local Government Act, 1933, for the Good Rule and Government of the County Borough of Southampton aforesaid.

No person shall in any place of entertainment to which the public are admitted with or without the payment of money, while the public are on the premises, use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned. Any person offending against this byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding five pounds.
