

# Legal Implications

- The Licensing Act 2003 specifically restricts the grounds on which the Council, as Licensing Authority (LA), may refuse an application for a new Premises Licence, or impose conditions. Where relevant representations are made, the LA may refuse on the grounds that the licensing objectives are not met or the operating schedule is inadequate. Equally, conditions may be imposed where relevant and necessary. The LA may also refuse an application in part and thereby only permit some of the licensable activities sought.
- 2. The decision making committee, in considering an application, must have regard to the adopted Statement of Licensing Policy and any relevant representations made by those directly affected.
- 3. An applicant for a new Premises Licence whose application has been refused, or who is aggrieved by conditions imposed, may appeal against the decision to the Magistrates' Court.
- 4. In considering this application the committee will sit in a quasi-judicial capacity and is thus obliged to consider applications in accordance with both the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005, and amending secondary legislation and the rules of natural justice. The practical effect of this is that the committee must makes its decision based on evidence submitted in accordance with the legislation and give adequate reasons for reaching it's decision.

The committee must also have regard to:-

5. Crime and Disorder Act 1998

Section 17 of the Crime and Disorder Act 1998 places the Council under a duty to exercise its various functions with due regard to the likely effect of the exercise of those functions on, and the need to do all that it reasonably can to prevent, crime and disorder in its area.

6. Human Rights Act 1998

The Act requires UK legislation to be interpreted in a manner consistent with the European Convention on Human Rights. It is unlawful for the Council to act in a way that is incompatible (or fail to act in a way that is compatible) with the rights protected by the Act. Any action undertaken by the Council that could have an effect upon another persons Human Rights must be taken having regard to the principle of Proportionality - the need to balance the rights of the individual with the rights of the community as a whole. Any action taken by the Council which affect another's rights must be no more onerous than is necessary in a democratic society. The matter set out in this report must be considered in light of the above obligations.

#### a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)

The standard practices listed below will be maintained at all times. All reasonable steps will be taken to ensure that the premises will have a positive impact upon the local environment and its residents at all times.

#### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

1. The 'red care' alarm system shall be operated and maintained at the premises.

An alarm system that meets a minimum standard of BSEN50131 grade 1 must be installed at the premises. A panic button facility must be provided at the counter.

At least 2 members of staff will be on the shop floor between 22.00 to closing time.

CCTV shall be installed, operated and maintained in agreement with the Police. The system will enable a frontal head and shoulders image of every person entering the premises. The system shall record in real time and operate whilst the premises are open for licensable activities. The recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days. Recordings shall be made available to an Authorised Officer or a Police Officer (subject to the Data Protection Act 1998) within 24 hours of any request.

Premises shall be well lit both inside and out to deter offenders and support the CCTV (subject to any planning constraints

#### c) Public safety

Appropriate fire safety procedures are in place along with applicances including fire extinguishers (Foam, H20 and CO2), fire blankets, internally illuminated fire exit signs, a smoke detector and emergency lighting. All appliances are checked annually and comply with relevant British Standards.

All fire escapes/escape routes will be clearly marked and kept free from obstructions at all times.

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

All customers are asked to leave quietly. Clear.and legible notices will be displayed to remind customers to leave quietly.

Ventilation and extract systems are designed and maintained so as to prevent noxious smells causing a nuisance to nearby properties.

Trade waste agreement to be maintained at all times.

#### e) The protection of children from harm

To protect the children from harm we have following steps taken

- 1- the premises are effectively and responsibly managed;
- 2- provision of a sufficient number of people employed or engaged
- 3- appropriate instruction, training and supervision of those employed or engaged



## EH Report

#### **Observations**

#### **External**

- The building is a detached two storey property in a mixed commercial and residential area, facing onto a busy single track road. It is not located in part of Southampton's main night time economy as it is located on the outskirts of the city centre.
- There are many nearby residential properties including; Flats at first floor level (above commercial premises) on Shirley Road facing number 282; a residential street immediately opposite; adjacent commercial properties have flats at first floor level; the road running parallel and to the rear of 282 comprises of residential properties.
- There are no alleged noise nuisance complaints relating to the premises on file, from dispersal or noise or extraction equipment, as this premises under the previous proprietor has closed before midnight.
- The doors and windows to the property are timber framed. The windows have openable fanlights and the door has no recloser.

# <u>Internal</u>

- Tables with seating for up to 8 persons are to be provided within the area immediately inside the door to the premises.
- Equipment is use will include deep fat fryers and a pizza oven. The mechanical extraction system required to remove excess heat, moisture and odour from the kitchen will be operating until close of the premises.

#### <u>Concerns</u>

- The potential for noise nuisance from customers using the takeaway.
- The potential for the premises to be a 'meeting area', with groups congregating outside, as this premises will be the only one nearby to open until early hours.
- Potential noise nuisance from extended use of mechanical extraction units.
- The doors and windows may remain open allowing break out of voices and noise from equipment.

#### <u>Notes</u>

Other nearby commercial properties serving hot foods are open only until 23.30 hours.

#### **Conclusion**

I am concerned about the potential for public nuisance from customers and the noise from extraction equipment having an adverse effect on the occupants of the nearby residential properties. The latest that the premises should be allowed to remain open is midnight.

#### **Recommendation**

A representation to licensing services.

#### Istanbul Grill, 282 Shirley Road: Application for License

I am writing to express a strong objection to the application from the above premises for a license to sell alcohol until 3am, Monday to Saturday and until 1am on Sundays.

As a resident of Shirley, living in Dyer Road which is very close to the property, and having small children, I am extremely concerned that granting a license to sell alcohol from these premises will lead to a significant rise in noise, disruption and anti-social behaviour.

Although Shirley Road itself is not predominantly residential, many of those who will consume the alcohol bought at this shop will disperse down into the side streets, particularly Dyer Road as it is a thoroughfare to the rest of Freemantle, and it is us as residents who will suffer the adverse consequences of any decision to grant such a licence. Shirley High Street and Shirley Road already have several outlets which sell alcohol into the night and, on Friday and Saturday evenings in particular, intoxicated individuals can often be heard shouting loudly in the streets, generally disturbing the peace, and in some cases becoming involved in acts of minor vandalism and violent altercations. Recently, several residents have had their car windows broken and the litter in the street, including alcohol drink containers, seems to have got noticeably worse. This creates not only a sense of disorder, but also feelings of insecurity, and granting a license to this establishment to sell alcohol is only likely to further exacerbate these problems.

Furthermore, in the case of this particular premises, a family resides in the adjacent property, and they are likely to suffer from a considerable increase in noise, litter, and anti-social behaviour as a result any decision to allow the Istanbul Grill to sell alcohol into the night.

Condition 03 of the above numbered planning permission restricts the hours that these premises are allowed to trade to between the hours of 9am to 11.30pm, Monday to Saturday; however the licence application seeks consent to trade until as late as 3am and 1am on Sundays (Monday morning).

Please note that irrespective of any licence granted, if the premises is found to operate outside the hours granted by the planning permission the Council will serve a Breach of Condition Notice upon the operator requiring that the business is only open within the permitted hours of the planning permission; 9am to 11.30pm, Monday to Saturday. Failure to comply with a Breach of Condition Notice can result in **immediate prosecution** in the Magistrates' Court, for which the maximum penalty, if convicted is £1,000 for a first and subsequent offence (i.e. each time it is proven that the premises has traded outside the permitted hours).

Should your client wish the business to trade during the hours as proposed on the licence application you should submit a planning application seeking a variation of the approved hours. An application can be obtained via the Council's website, <u>http://www.southampton.gov.uk/</u>. Whilst each application is determined on its merits it is unlikely that consent would be granted for the opening hours that are proposed in the premises application.

Please can you ensure that your client is fully aware of the planning restrictions and the consequences for operating outside the permitted trading hours as allowed by planning permission so as to avoid the need for any future enforcement action to be taken.
