## 12. HACKNEY CARRIAGE LICENCES – UNMET DEMAND SURVEY

The Committee considered the report of the Assistant Solicitor to the Council setting out a report by the Halcrow Group Limited concerning Hackney Carriage demand in relation to the City Council's current policy of numerical control of the number of Hackney Carriage Licences issued. **RESOLVED** that in accordance with the Council's Constitution, specifically the Access to Information Rules, the press and public be excluded from the meeting to enable the Committee to receive legal advice in relation to the various options set out in the report on grounds based on Category 5 of paragraph 10.4 of the Council's Access to Information Procedure Rules regarding information in respect of which a claim to legal professional privilege could be maintained in legal proceedings.

The Committee returned to public session to allow the Assistant Solicitor to the Council to set out the legal advice given in private session and for the Committee to consider the various options contained in the report.

**RESOLVED** that Option 3 as detailed in the report to increase the number of Hackney Carriage plates by issuing an additional twenty Hackney Carriage licences to meet the unmet demand identified in the independent consultants report over a period of three years (4 licences on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2009, 8 licences on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2010 and 8 licences on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2011), based on the conditions set out in paragraph 13 of the report and subject to further clarification in a detailed report on conditions of issue to the next meeting, be approved.
