## THE DECISION

To approve, in accordance with Financial Procedure Rules, capital expenditure of £1.2M on mandatory Disabled Facilities Grants, phased £900,000 in 2014/15 and £300,000 in 2015/16, provision for which is contained within the Housing General Fund Capital Programme.

### REASONS FOR THE DECISION

- (i) Approval to spend £1.2M on Disabled Facilities Grants approved during the 2014/15 financial year will help the Council meet its statutory duty to award these grants to adapt the homes of vulnerable disabled people.
- (ii) Funding for these grants was approved by full Council in February 2014 and is contained within the Housing General Fund Capital Programme.

## **DETAILS OF ANY ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS**

Not spending this resource on Disabled Facilities Grants would mean that the Council would not fulfil its statutory duty to award these mandatory grants and this would not be consistent with the Council Plan and Housing Strategy.
