

CSL buildings affected by the savings proposals CS 1, CS 7 and CS 18

No	Building	Possible future use
1	Newtown Youth Centre	Council owned. Negotiate with community to take over building and provide universal youth provision
2	Newtown Adventure Playground	Council owned.
3	Northam Youth Club	Council owned but managed by community centre. Negotiate with community group to take over delivery of the programme.
4	Millbrook Youth Club	Council owned convert into training space – managed through Inspire. Current costs associated with hiring training facilities would offset cost.
5	The Link, Windrush Road, Millbrook	Council owned – housing portfolio. Provision has been relocated to children's centres, schools and colleges. Need to identify alternative provider or dispose of building.
6	Swaythling Youth Club	Operates out of Swaythling neighbour centre – minimal provision. Could identify alternative provider for one night a week provision.
7	Woodlands Youth Club	School owned building. Provision two nights a week. Pass building to school for full time use delivering alternative education provision and possibly some youth provision.
8	Woolston Youth Centre	St Marks institution own building. Community centre in the centre of Woolston. We pay an annual fee for a floor in the building.
9	Townhill Hill Park Youth Club	Council owned children centre. Delivery of one night a week. Alternative provider could be identified.
10	Sholing Shop	Council owned – delivery of one night a week provision. Police Community Support Officers use site as a drop in.
11	Coxford Adventure Playground	Council owned. No council youth provision operates from the site. A voluntary group provides boxing.
12	Zoe Braithwaite Centre	Council owned –old scout hut. Delivery of four afternoons' week and Saturday supervised play for 5 – 14 year olds. Oasis Lordshill use building during the day for some alternative provision. Opportunity to ask the school to take over the centre and afternoon provision.

1	Bitterne Family Centre	Current usage: family support work with children and families involved in court care proceedings and or children subject to a Child Protection Plan. Possible relocation of contact services.
2	Forest View Family Centre	Current usage: family support work with children and families involved in court care proceedings and or children subject to a Child Protection Plan. Possibly relocation of CYPDS.

3	Derby Road Family Centre	Possibly relocate social care staff or dispose.
4	Salerno Road	Use for 'Our House' currently

1	Central Children's Centre (Clovelly) Full core offer centre	Service redesign to integrate current activity delivered through three teams and in three locations into one service point: Integrated Children and Family Centres
2	Weston Children's Centre Full core offer centre	The centres will delivering, directly to local residents but not exclusively the following services: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Statutory children's centres programme • Statutory social care family work programmes, including court ordered activity • Parental support programmes and family support
3	Thornhill and Harefield Children's Centre Full core offer centre	Ideally, case workers working with families on the families matter programmes will use the centres.
4	North Shirley Children's Centre Full core offer centre	The centre will seek to address, through providing a locally accessible preventative support and challenge services, based on a family intervention model – address the needs of the whole family.
5	Lordshill/Shirley Children's Centre Full core offer centre	Children's Centres current purpose: to provide accessible universal, target and specialist cross agency support to parents of under 5 year olds. Family Centres current purpose: to assess significant risk and work with families to improve parental capacity safely. Where capacity is not available, evidence gather to remove children and place for long term alternative care – such as adoption, fostering, kinship care etc.
6	Warren/Coxford Children's Centre Full core offer centre	Parental support programmes current purpose: preventative case work with parents with high level of needs with regarding parenting capacity – who are not eligible for social care intervention.
7	Swaythling Children's Centre Full core offer centre	Used for 2 preschools delivered by LA as well as a non full core offer CC
8	Startpoint Sholing	Pre school run by LA
