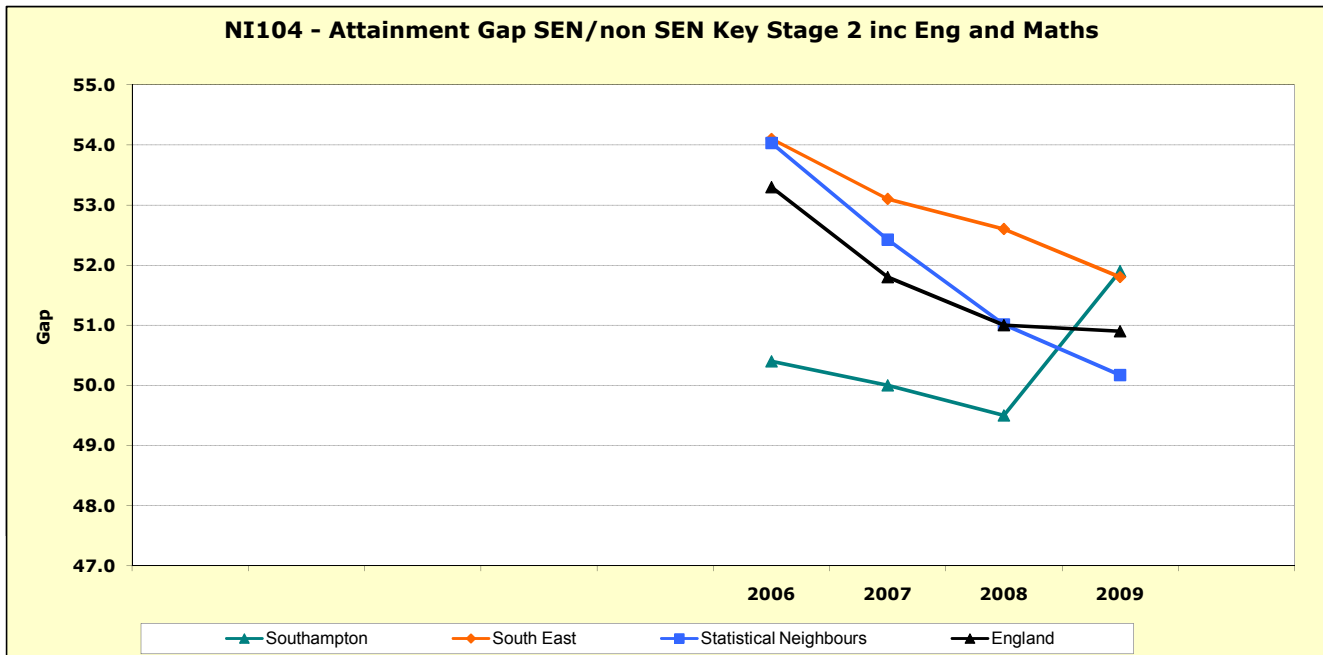

Description:

The percentage point gap between pupils who are identified as having special educational needs who achieve the expected level at Key Stage 2 and those who have not been identified as such.

Methodology:

By way of example, if 700 pupils with no identified SEN achieve Key Stage 2 level 4+ in English and Maths and a total of 1000 pupils with no SEN but are eligible for assessment at KS2; and if 150 pupils who have SEN identified achieve Key Stage 2 level 4+ in English and Maths whilst there are 300 pupils who have SEN and eligible for assessment at KS2 then the percentage point gap is 20 percentage points, using this formula:-

$$((700/1000)*100)-((150/300)*100)$$
. Good performance is typified by lower percentage point gaps between pupils identified as having SEN and those not.
