20. <u>APPLICATION FOR A SEX SHOP LICENCE - THE ADULT SHOP, 90 HOWARD ROAD</u>

The Sub-Committee considered the confidential report of the Solicitor to the Council regarding an application for a sex shop licence in respect of the Adult Gift Shop, 90 Howard Road, attached. (Copy of report circulated with agenda and appended to signed minutes).

Mr Hale (Applicant) and Mr Grey (Counsel for the Applicant) were present and with the consent of the Chair addressed the meeting.

RESOLVED that the application for a sex shop licence in respect of the Adult Gift Shop, 90 Howard Road, be granted subject to the Council's standard conditions for sex establishments and the following special conditions:-

- (i) Conditions 1 to 4 as set out in the report; and
- (ii) an amendment of the standard conditions regarding opening hours be permitted to ensure trading hours be the same as the other sex shops currently licensed by the City Council 09.00 to 22.00 Monday to Saturday with no trading permitted on public holidays.

REASON FOR THE DECISION

There was no compelling evidence presented to the Sub-Committee that would justify refusal of the application for renewal of the licence.

The Sub-Committee stressed that any breach of conditions would be viewed very seriously in the future, particularly that condition relating to persons not properly authorised being involved with the business.
