This statement (consisting of page(s) each signed by me) is true to the best of my knowledge and belief and I make it knowing that, if it is tendered in evidence, I shall be liable to prosecution if I have wilfully stated in it, anything which / know to be false, or do not believe to be true.

I am PC 24191 Bethan WOOD of Hampshire Constabulary, currently stationed at Southampton Central police station, attached to the Violent Crime \& Licensing Team.

On the $2^{\text {nd }}$ December 2011 I was on duty in full uniform. At about 2340 hrs I heard a request via Licensing Link Radio for a paramedic to attend Chilli Whites, in VINCENTS WALK, SOUTHAMPTON. I therefore went to that location, from there I commenced a foot patrol of the city centre, starting at Chill Whites.

On arrival at the premises I was met by several Street Pastors, who were with a male who I now know to be Jordan POINTER (28/01/92). POINTER was sat in the covered entrance area to the premises and was being propped up by a street pastor on one side, and the premises 'Nanny' who I believe to be called 'Freya' on the other. He was clearly in drink. He was unable to support himself, his pupils were dilated, his speech was slurred, and he smelt of intoxicating liquor. POINTER also kept grinding his jaw in a downwards and sideways motion. He was making very little sense in what he was saying and his details had to be obtained from the passport in his trouser pockets.

I was advised by a Street Pastor that POINTER had consumed three cans of 'Crunk Juice', and taken both Viagra and Ecstasy before coming out into the city centre. He had consumed four double vodka and red bull drinks whilst within Chilli Whites. I was advised by Steve HUDSON, who is the Designated Premises Supervisor, that the male had been in the premises for about half an hour before being discovered slumped in a heap at the back of the premises. I do not know how he knew this as he didn't view CCTV whilst I was there.

My immediate concern was for POINTER's welfare. He was being offered water but was virtually unable to control his head movements in order to drink it. I asked Freya whether his friends had been contacted, but was advised that he couldn't tell them his friends names. It was only when I suggested getting the DJ to turn down music, and make an announcement for 'Friends of Jordan POINTER' that his friends appeared. This hadn't even occurred to staff.

Two of POINTER's friends came outside and were cleariy shocked at his state. Both friends stated that he had been drinking before going out, and that he was drunk prior to entering Chill Whites. The friends were able to support POINTER between them and took him back to the University Halls where he is currently staying.

As an experienced officer I was amazed at the state of POINTER given that he had only been in the premises for 30 minutes. I doubt very much that anybody could deteriorate from being sober enough to allow into a licensed premises, to being completely incapable, in such a short space of time. It didn't surprise me that his friends stated he was drunk prior to entry.
