

Subsequent to the meeting held 13th January 2016 the number of maintained Special School places has been reviewed. The number of places programmed for Great Oaks should have been 178 by September 2016 and not the 170 originally provided for calculation. This resulted a slight increase in pressure due to place funding for the additional places however, as a result of a full review of all maintained special schools places top-up bandings, based on the latest data provided by the schools, the net cost of pressure is negligible and can be managed within the budget available.
