### THE DECISION

To approve the signing of the Covenant of Mayors adhesion form, as set out in Appendix 2, for submission to the European Commission, as a commitment to meeting and exceeding the EU 20%  $CO_2$  reduction target.

## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

- 1. Participating in the Covenant of Mayors initiative would allow Southampton the opportunity to exchange information with key European cities and further highlight the City's commitment to tackling climate change on the international stage.
- 2. Through participation in the Leadership in Energy Action and Planning (LEAP) project, the development of a Sustainable Energy Action Plan for Southampton is well underway, making it an appropriate time to join the Covenant of Mayors.

This would result in a missed opportunity to improve performance through access to a network of signatory cities and no clear route-map supplementing the clear targets and established management framework already in place through the Low Carbon City Strategy.
