Please note that there will be a Licensing Committee meeting at 11 am on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> April 2015. The full committee papers will be posted on the Council's website and I will send you a link to it when it becomes available. The Committee is being asked to consider a request by some of the Applicants to determine whether any and if so which of the applicants may show their casinos at Stage 2 of the competition on plots WQ2, WQ3 or WQ4 or determine whether it has a discretion to permit the submission of new Stage 1 applications, whether for the said plots or elsewhere. If so, determine whether it should exercise its discretion to permit such submission.

Finally it may decide to ignore the various requests and continue the process retaining the original closure date of 16<sup>th</sup> April 2015.
