8 GLOSSARY OF TERMS

LEGIBILITY	-	Understanding of the layout of the city and what goes on in it.
PERMEABILITY	-	The extent to which the city offers people a choice of access through it (from place to place) is a key measure of the quality of environment.
ICONOGRAPHIC	-	A building of exceptional quality that is clearly related to a particular city/location.
RHYTHM	-	A regular pattern of elements occuring within a building or group of buildings.
ARTICULATE	-	The way materials and form of a building express the designers aims and the function of the building.
PALETTE	-	A range (normally associated with materials).
