There are people who work at the library who I can talk to

Sometimes it might be noisy. If it is noisy I can talk to a librarian or I can wear my ear defenders if I have some.



How I become a member of the library

When I get to the library I will see a desk



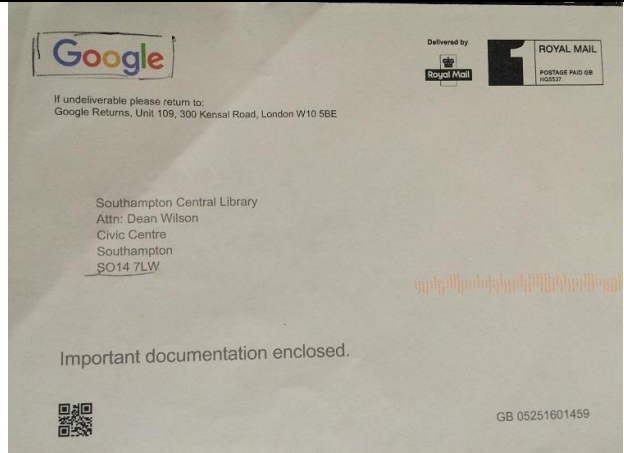
I will talk to someone who works there to become a member of the library



If I joined online I will show the letter and card sent to me in the post otherwise I will tell them my name, address, date of birth, telephone number and email address



I will show them identification. This can be a driving licence, bank statement or household bill



I will sign my library card, this makes me a member of the library



When I visit the library

In the library there will be shelves of books



I can sit in a chair to read a book



I can borrow a book and take it home with me



If I want to borrow a book I will talk to a member of the library staff



The staff will show me how to borrow the book and tell me when I need to bring it back to the library



The library will also have some computers that I can use



When I have finished I will leave the library
