To:

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the County Borough of Southampton, the Local Planning Authority for the said County Borough, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, duly made on the 7th day of September 1962 a Direction that the permission granted by paragraph (1) of Article 3 of the said Order should not apply to the development described in the Second Schedule hereto in respect of the area described in the First Schedule hereto

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the said Direction was duly approved by the Minister of Housing and Local Government on the 23rd day of October 1962

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that in accordance with paragraph (4) of Article 4 of the said Order the said Direction will come into force on the date of service of this Notice upon you, namely the 2nd day of November 1962.

THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1950

WHEREAS the Council of the County Borough of Southampton being the Local Planning Authority for the said County Borough are satisfied that it is expedient that the erection of a garage, stable, loose-box or coach-house within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse which development is by virtue of the proviso to paragraph (1) of Class I of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1950 treated as an enlargement of the dwellinghouse for the purposes of Class I of the said Order which is permitted by paragraph (1) of Article 3 so long as the cubic content of the original dwellinghouse (as ascertained by external measurement) is not exceeded by more than 1,750 cubic feet or one tenth whichever is the greater subject to a maximum of 4,000 cubic feet should not be carried out in the area described in the First Schedule hereto unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf under the said Order

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1950 hereby direct that the permission granted by paragraph (1) of Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse described in the Second Schedule hereto
