COUNTY BOROUGH OF SOUTHAMPTON

PROVISIONAL TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL INTERIM DEVELOPMENT) ORDER, 1946

WHEREAS the Council of the County Borough of Southampton being the interim development authority for the said County Borough are satisfied that it is expedient having regard to provisions proposed to be included in the planning scheme for the land situate in the County Borough of Southampton and more particularly described in the First Schedule hereto that any development of the description set out in the Second Schedule hereto should not be undertaken on the said land unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Provisional Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1946;

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 6(2) of the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1945, hereby direct that the provisions of paragraph (1) of Article 4 of the said Order shall not apply to development of the description set out in the Second Schedule hereto on the said land.

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

Class III. The rebuilding, restoration or replacement of buildings and plants, which have sustained war damage.

PROVIDED that this Direction shall not have effect in relation to the following development:-

The restoration or replacement of plant, the carrying out of operations immediately necessary in consequence of war damage for avoiding danger to health, or preventing the deterioration of any building, or otherwise required for temporarily meeting the circumstances created by the damage, and the carrying out of any operations for the rebuilding, restoration or replacement of buildings which have sustained war damage, the total cost of which does not exceed the sum of £100.

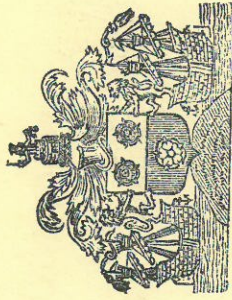
