MOT Testing and Certificates

You may have heard that the government have given the public a 6 month extension on their MOT test. To be clear, the government is allowing MOT centres and garages to remain open. So you can still get an MOT for your vehicle.

If drivers have been instructed by licensing to obtain an MOT test, they should still do this between the dates stated in their letter. They should not take the certificate into the council. We will check, as we always have, online to ensure compliance.

If drivers are self-isolating and cannot carry out the test, we will suspend the vehicle until such time as the driver is fit and the test is done. Note that this can only be for a maximum of two months. After this, the vehicle licence will be revoked and a new licence must be applied for if this is possible.

At this time, Adams Morey remains open and operational as usual. Drivers should turn up for their mechanical inspections as stated in their renewal letter.

Public safety remains our number one priority at this time. This advice is under constant review and should there be any change I will notify the trade as best as I can, including on the Taxi Noticeboard on our website.
