As you may be aware the locally agreed Syllabus is currently being reviewed, revised and rewritten – this will be launched to schools Autumn term 2016. Training and support will be available during Autumn 2016.

How to get information on RE?

There are many ways to do this, increasingly so online, for example through NATRE (National Association for RE) and RE today website to name but two.

There are a wide range of books to support knowledge of religions that are helpful for teachers who are new to RE or those who need to boost their Religious Literacy.
