Our policy on the fitting of screens in vehicles remains:

We will not stand in drivers way if during the pandemic if they wish to fit screens in their vehicles. However, they must not interfere with any of the vehicle's safety systems or camera.

However, we will refer to these new government guidelines when examining screens and expect screens to comply with them. Therefore, vehicle owners and operators should check to ensure that if they have a screen fitted that it is compliant with this new guidance.
