

Legal Documentation Checklist

The following is the legal documentation and payment required in setting up a Deferred Payment Agreement. All must be provided before Southampton City Council can enter into the agreement.

Documentation required:

• The completed & signed Deferred Payment Agreement application form.

• It is essential the property is registered with the land registry and a land registry search will be carried out to confirm this. If the property is registered in joint names with a deceased spouse or partner, then a copy of the relevant death certificate will be required.

• A copy of the buildings insurance policy showing the expiry date and evidence that the property is insured whilst unoccupied.

• An original copy or a certified copy of the Lasting Power of Attorney or Enduring Power of Attorney, if applicable.

• Full name, address and contact details for the person who is representing the resident, including email address, if applicable.

• If a Solicitor is appointed, their full contact address details and telephone number and the name of the solicitor acting.

• If the Deferred Payment Agreement is to be signed by a legal representative (e.g. Lasting Power of Attorney/Enduring Power of Attorney), then proof of identity is required for both the service user and their legal representative; either:

ONE of the following:

o Current valid full passport

o Current UK, EU, Isle of Man, Channel Islands (Photo card Style) Full Driving Licence

o In the absence of a passport or a driving licence, the Birth Certificate

OR

TWO of the following:

Utility Bill (less than 3 months old) i.e. Gas, Electricity or Telephone

Council Tax Bill for the current financial year

Debit or Credit Card issued by a Bank / Building Society (i.e. MasterCard / Visa / Maestro / Delta / Amex / Diners Club)

AND a related statement less than 3 months old

Mortgage Statement for the year most recently ended.
