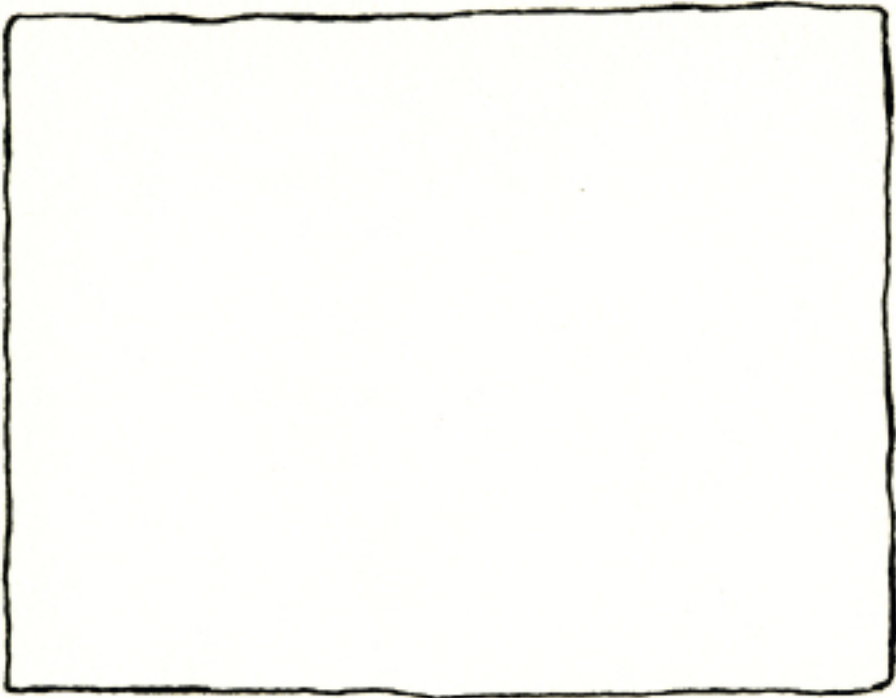

if I want to.



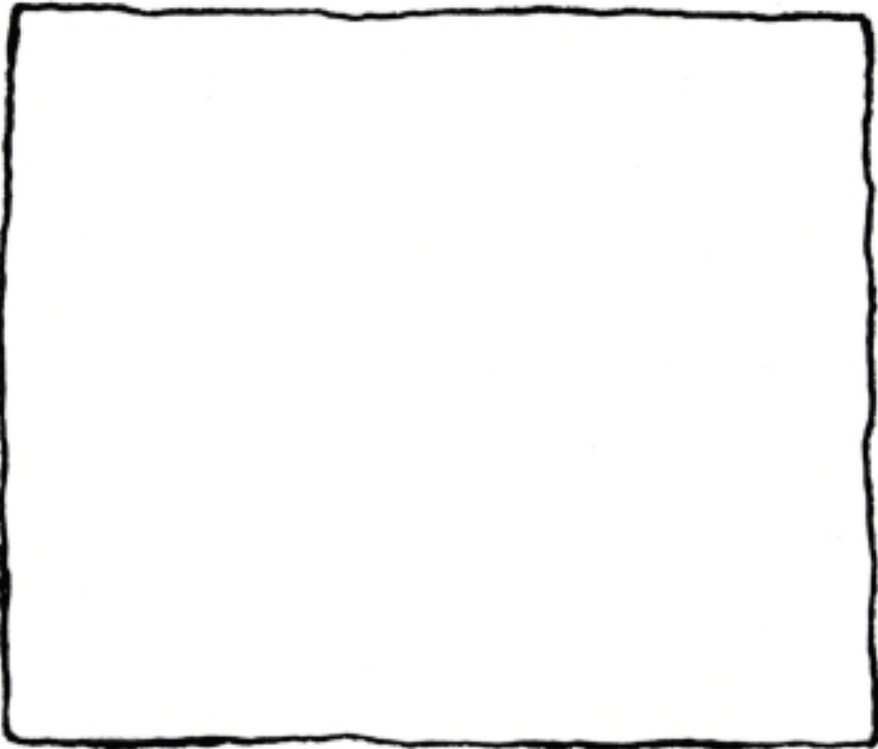
When I visit, I can normally
