Clean Air - Change of Conditions for Wheelchair Accessable Vehicles

As you may already be aware, Southampton City Council is required to reduce levels of pollution in the city as quickly as possible and has therefore been required by central government to implement changes that will reduce emissions and improve air quality. These changes mean diesel vehicles with a euro 5 standard of engine will be removed from the fleet by the end of 2022.

Both the Licensing department and the trade have been concerned for some time that there seems to be a lack of suitable alternative wheelchair accessible vehicles (WAV's) available to replace those vehicles as there are no viable hybrid designs filtering through the marketplace. This is likely to lead to a shortage of WAV's and have a detrimental effect on those passengers and the proprietors and businesses that operate them.

As a result of these concerns, the Clean Air Team submitted a change request to our commitment to DEFRA to allow WAVs, within the age policy, with a Euro 5 diesel engine an extra two years to remain licensed. Note that this change will not affect vehicles that cannot be renewed because they exceed the age limit on this type of vehicle which remains set at 12 years. This will apply to vehicles currently licensed only, we will be unable to licence any euro 5 diesel vehicles as either new vehicles or by a change of vehicle.

The additional condition proposed to be added to vehicle licences:

3.5.3 No diesel wheelchair accessible vehicle with an emissions standard of level 5 (Euro 5) or lower will be licensed or relicensed by way of renewal on or after 1st January 2024 unless the vehicle has been converted with approved CVRAS technology. See 3.5.2

Section 3.5.1 will be amended as follows:

3.5.1 With the exception of vehicles detailed in 3.5.3 no diesel vehicle with an emissions standard of level 5 (Euro 5) or lower will be licensed or relicensed by way of renewal

The consultation will last for eight weeks, commencing on Monday 5th July, finishing at midnight on Sunday 29th August 2021. Those taking part in the consultation will be expected to provide their name address and/or email address. However, they may choose to provide further personal data to illustrate or support their views. The personal data provided might include an address or area they live in, place of work, occupation, medical conditions. The original emails will be retained in line with the Council's retention policy.

Once the consultation process is complete the comments made along with the name of the person making each comment will be made available to Councillors and published via the Council's website. The legal basis for using personal data in this way is because it is necessary for activities that support or promote democratic engagement. This information will remain available on the Council website. If you submit a comment as part of the consultation process and you would not like your name or any part of your comments published please make this clear in your email or letter. To support the trade in meeting these requirements, grants have been made available to upgrade from a non-compliant vehicle to a hybrid, plug-in hybrid or full electric vehicle. From May 2019 grants were also be available to upgrade wheelchair accessible or vehicles that can carry 5-8 passengers from non-compliant to euro 5 or 6 petrol and euro 6 diesel. Funding will continue to be offered until the end of this year as funds allow. Details can be found here:

- The current vehicle won't be re-licensed as a taxi or private hire vehicle.
- The new vehicle will meet all other licensing requirements
- The new vehicle has not already been licensed as a taxi or private hire vehicle in Southampton.
- The new vehicle will remain licensed in Southampton for three years with the same proprietorship.

- Vehicle proprietors are limited to a maximum grant award of £7,000 each
- Applications will only be considered when submitted prior to the new vehicle being licensed.
