## 19. PRESENTATION REGARDING THE REVISED SYLLABUS

AP presented the revised syllabus after which there was a discussion. It was noted that extensive debate and discussion had taken place about the chosen Golden Thread words and the diverse approaches to those words across the Key Stages.

**RESOLVED** that the rational and the definition of Golden Thread be agreed.
