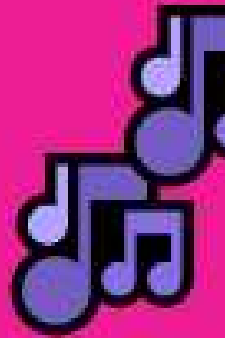

Vlog video created after each trip to document the experience

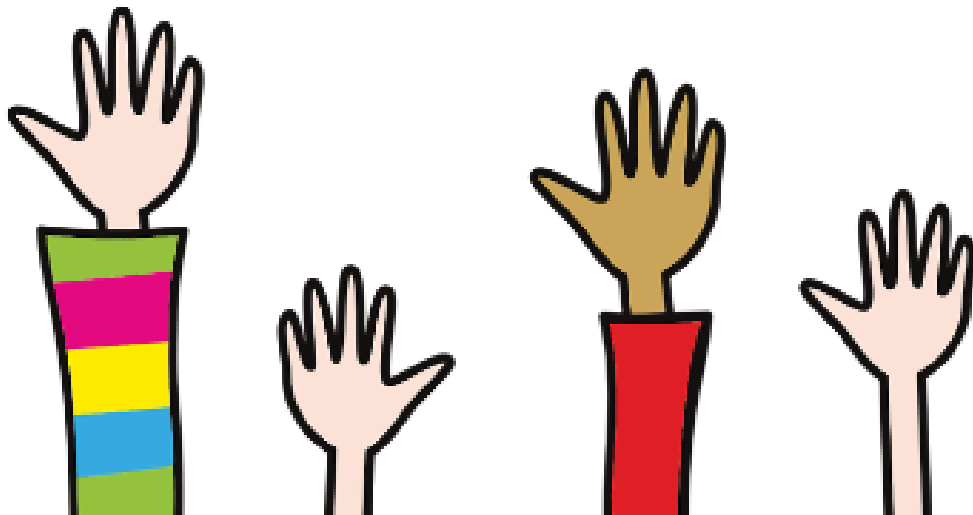
- Tough application process with strong competition
