3. Attached as Appendix 1 is an introduction to the Modernising our Hospitals and Health Services Programme. Also attached, as Appendices 2 and 3, are							

	the summary and full consultation documents, produced by the Integrated Care Board that provide more detail on the proposals.					
4.	The HOSP, at a meeting in October 2020, determined that the changes being proposed within the Hampshire Together - Modernising our Hospitals and Health Services programme, represented a substantial change/variation in service. Hampshire County Council's Health Overview and Scrutiny Committee also reached the same decision.					
5.	A joint committee, comprising 8 Members, with 7 being appointed by Hampshire County Council and 1 being appointed by Southampton City Council, was subsequently appointed in December 2020 for the purposes of providing independent scrutiny to the Hampshire Together – Modernising our Hospitals and Health Services Programme. The Committee has met on 5 occasions and is the lead committee scrutinising the proposals and the consultation programme.					
6.	The Integrated Care Board are now undertaking a public consultation on the proposed options. The consultation began on 11 December 2023 and will run for 14 weeks until midnight 17 March 2024.					
7.	Given the potential impact of the proposed options on health services in Southampton, the Chair has requested that the Panel are consulted on the options being considered. The Panel are therefore asked to discuss the proposals, outlined within the appendices, with the invited representatives and to consider providing feedback to the ongoing consultation.
