

Variable trends in overall attainment across all Areas of Learning








Southampton's stable trend was mirrored nationally and there is no relative change of the Local Authority's position to National

Key Stage 1 - % achieving the Expected Standard




Southampton Key Stage 1 outcomes at the Expected Standard have regressed from 2018 and are below the National average in 2019






The 2019 Key Points in Summary

EYFS	In-line with National
Phonics	Outcome remains steady and in-line with a stable National average
Key Stage 1	A regression in Expected Standard+ threshold outcomes relative to National across all of Reading, Writing & Maths resulting in performance below the National average
	Continued Greater Depth threshold outcomes below National across all of Reading, Writing & Maths
Key Stage 2	Overall KS2 attainment below National for the first time in seven years
	Regression in Reading & Maths progress although in-line with National. Progress in Writing significantly below National for the third consecutive year
Primary Phase	Challenges remain around attainment in Writing at the higher threshold
Key Stage 4	Improved attainment in 2019 from a more able cohort. 2019 progress predicted to be broadly similar to that in 2018.
Key Stage 5	A-Level threshold outcomes improved but below the National average
