With the hope of achieving a favourable outcome, the Chair has decided that the letter to the Secretary of State not be sent at this time because of the reassuring words and actions coming from officers in the providers and commissioning organisation. However it must be noted that the Panel has not received written confirmation of the intention to move toward a network model from either hospital.
