7. TAXI LICENSING POLICY STATEMENT 2021

The panel considered the report of the Executive Director – Communities, Culture and Homes which sought approval of consultation documents for a new taxi policy statement.

Southampton City Council Officers Phil Bates, Licensing Manager; Russel Hawkins, Senior Licensing Officer; and Andrew Saunders, Senior Policy, Partnerships and Strategic Planning Officer; were present and with the consent of the Chair addressed the meeting.

The Committee noted that Drivers would be required to complete a basic English and Maths Test, Safeguarding Training, and a Disclosure and Barring Service Check every 6 months. The Committee were also mindful that the Code of Conduct should set out clearly that the provision of Taxi services must be non-political and threats to any officer of the council will not be tolerated.

RESOLVED that:

- (i) The draft Statement of Taxi Licensing Policy and appendices have been approved for consultation for a period of three months
- (ii) Authority would be delegated to the Licensing Manager in consultation with Communications to agree appropriate questions to be using in the consultation correspondence.
