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STATEMENT OF CONFIDENTIALITY

It is not in the public interest to disclose this financial information as it directly relates to the value of property interests in the site which may be adversely affected resulting in a barrier to the construction of a new school site or the disposal of those interests to enable the land assembly to be completed.
