## Table of Fees, Payments and Sums

Fixed and settled under Section 34 of the Burial Act, 1852, by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Southampton, acting by the Council as the Burial Authority in respect of the South Stoneham Cemetery, including the Old Burial Ground, and that portion of the St. Mary Extra Cemetery which was provided under the Burial Acts.

---

Notwithstanding anything contained in the tables of fees, payments and sums, fixed and settled by the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Southampton, acting by the Council as the Burial Authority in respect of that portion of the St. Mary Extra Cemetery which was provided under the Burial Acts, and the South Stoneham Cemetery, including the Old Burial Ground, on the Nineteenth day of September, 1928, and approved by the Minister of Health on the Ninth day of January, 1929.

Where the bodies of two or more members of the same family who have died in consequence of war operations are interred at the same time in the same grave or vault, an interment fee in respect of one body only shall be payable under these tables, which fee, where fees of different amounts would otherwise be payable, shall be the higher or the highest as the case may be.
