

CITY OF SOUTHAMPTON

BYELAWS

Made under section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875 sections 12 and 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906 section 87 of the Southampton Corporation Act 1910 and section 10 of the Commons Act 1899 by Southampton City Council with respect to Pleasure Grounds.

The series of byelaws with respect to Pleasure Grounds made by the Council on 12th April 1967 and confirmed by the Secretary of State on 31st July 1967 as amended by a byelaw made by the Council on 26th July 1977 and confirmed by the Secretary of State on 6th October 1977 is hereby further amended and extended as follows:-

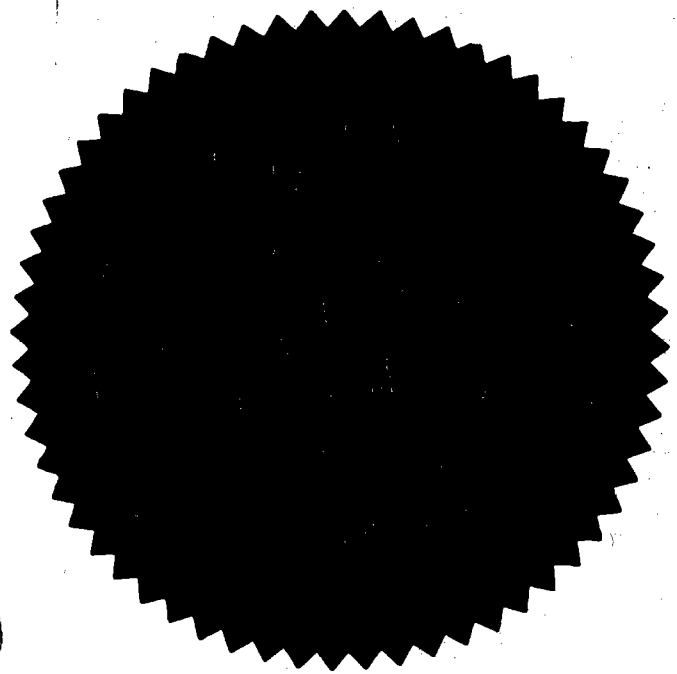
- (1) In the list of pleasure grounds in Byelaw 1(1) of the aforesaid series immediately after the words "Lawn Road" there shall be inserted the words "Lord's Hill Recreation Centre being the land west of Romsey Road and north of Brownhill Way"
- (2) At the end of the proviso to Byelaw 6(ii) of the aforesaid series there shall be added the words "and provided that paragraph (ii) of this Byelaw shall not apply to any Cycleway on Lord's Hill Recreation Centre which is designated and clearly marked as such cycleway by the Council"
- (3) In Byelaw 22 of the aforesaid series for the words "a fine not exceeding five pounds" there shall be substituted the words "a fine not exceeding fifty pounds"
- (4) These Byelaws may be cited as the City of Southampton Pleasure Grounds (Amendment) Byelaws 1981
